Synopsis of Workshop

Reflection activities offer a unique opportunity to improve learning in engineering education. The Consortium to Promote Reflection in Engineering Education (CPREE) is a coalition of 12 institutions from across the U.S. The goal of the consortium has been to study and promote reflection in engineering education through a focus on the use of reflection activities in engineering education contexts.

In this workshop we will build on the documented CPREE reflection activities, as well as CPREE's experience working with educators to integrate reflection activities into their teaching. Specifically, workshop participants will

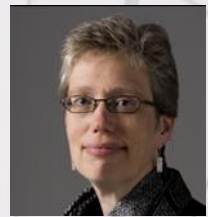
1. examine reflection activities that have been conducted by engineering educators,
